

2022 ACCI Conference COVID Protocols

We are so glad that we can now attend the conference in person and wish to be careful in our meeting and clear about how ACCI is addressing safety. Be assured that safety is a priority, and we will do everything possible to minimize the spread of COVID-19, though we cannot guarantee that attendees will not be exposed to that or other illnesses during the 2022 Annual Conference in Clearwater Beach May 19-21, 2022.

- All attendees will be **required to show proof of full vaccination at conference check-in or proof of a negative test within three days of arrival.** We understand that this is personal health information, and we will not keep a copy, we only need to verify your vaccine record. A photo of your record on your phone will be acceptable
- The conference is <u>Mask Friendly</u>. We are in a hotel where many guests are not related to our conference, and you will be passing them in the hall and in the hotel outlets. Wearing a mask is your personal choice.
- We ask that all attendees and exhibitors certify at registration check-in that you have **not experienced any symptoms associated with COVID-19**, had a positive COVID-19 test, or been exposed to someone with COVID, within 7-days prior to arrival on site.
- We recommend that you adhere to social distancing throughout the event. At check-in, you will select a sticker for your name tag to indicate your personal comfort level with physical distancing.

Red = you want to strictly adhere to the 6-ft. distance protocol with everyone. Yellow = you are comfortable standing in closer proximity but do not wish to shake hands or engage in physical contact.

Green = you are open to handshakes and other close contact.

- **Observe room capacity and table seating limits.** Chairs will be spaced specifically to provide adequate distance and you may be asked to move based on table spacing.
- Self-monitor for COVID-19 symptoms that may develop during the conference and immediately notify ACCI staff if symptoms develop.
- Hand sanitizer is available throughout the hotel for your use.
- Notify the ACCI office should you test positive after the conference so that we may anonymously notify other attendees.

In general, we ask that that everyone be aware and respect these prevention policies for the good of everyone attending. This means being aware and allowing adequate spacing in lines for check-in, food service, in elevators, and on the dinner cruise, etc.
